Point-based decks

Players have found that the normal deck limit of 8 can be abused, especially if the majority of the cards used are rare. Point-based decks are a different way of limiting the card makeup of a deck. They require a little more preparation time, but ensure a fair game.

Prior to play, you and your opponent must agree on a point total for the game – a total of 200 to 250 points makes for a good game. Each of you should then construct decks with a value equal to or less than this total. A deck's value is equal to the value of the cards in it. Each card with a printed Supply Cost has a value equal to the Supply Cost. Special cards with no printed cost are valued by rarity. Common cards are worth 3 points each. Uncommon cards are worth 5 points each. Rare and Promo cards are worth 10 points each.
